- 1.1 Population trained on water and sanitation, each household has a tippy tap and are using it.
- 1.2 All pregnant mother have information about maternal health and know where to access antenatal services.
- 1.3 Communities sensitized about HIV/AIDS and are aware about available HIV services
- 1.4 HIV/AIDS patients access RVS
- 1.5 Nutrition for HIV/AIDS widows improved

- 3.4 More trainings in income generating activities organized for women and youths
